Update - Lincoln Station Adoption Project - At last things are on track!

- 1 – Platform 6 clean up – Dead vegetation over the years had formed a thick crust of soil and dead plants, which has now been cleared back to the platform. EMT are putting a membrane down to stop further growth & Network Rail have kindly agreed to donate 25 tons of small ballast to go on top - It looks so much better!
- 2- Platform Planters – Four planters have been kindly donated by Lincoln BIG and are now on site. Pelican Trust are making wooden panels to surround the planters and make them look attractive. Richard Pennell is supplying compost and bedding plants at cost. The University of Lincoln is sponsoring these.
- 3 – Photos. Henry Ruddock is printing off the photos in rough form and we will see how they look in the waiting rooms before going for the finished article. Travel posters are on order from NRM>
- 4 – Lincolnshire Co-operative Society is keen to sponsor two planters outside the station entrance, we are just getting clearance from EMT but they would look lovely.
